Then students performed special cultural program for their teachers to make them happy and feel special in every way possible which include felicitation of teachers.



## Objective

## **Discussion and Training Activities**

The basic recipe of a cake was discussed first. It contains only four essential ingredients flour, sugar, and butter in 1:1:1:1 ratio. The optional ingredients are baking powder, baking soda, custard powder, milk powder, molasses, nuts, cream, and spices. In eggless cake, condensed milk is added in place of egg. In normal sponge, the amount of butter is decreased and oil is added. The most basic tools of a pastry chef are cake stand, palate knife and bread knife.

- Chocolate truffle
- Fondant icing
- Royal icing



Indian institute of Food processing technologies (IIFPT) will launch new technologies and product on its 'open day event' on 16 september2017, which is intended at sensitizing the public on food safety and hygiene. The event has been organized to commemorate the 115<sup>th</sup> Birth Anniversary of the institutes founder Director, V. Subrahmanyan.

According to the director of the institute C.Anandharamakrishnan as part of the event, IIFPT's technology pavilion was in augurated by commissioner of agriculture marketing and Agri business, Shunchonngam Jatak chiru while the food tech expo will be inaugurated by the chief general manager, nabard, SNA Jinnah. He added that the instate was releasing its newly developed technology/gadgets which have significant field application in food processing sector.

On September, 16 2017 we the students of Food Science & Nutrition Department attended the Indian Institute of Food Technology (IIFPT) open day. It is the common event. All the public can take part in it and from our college around 30 students participated in this open day celebration of Indian Institute of Food Processing Technology IIFPT, Tanjore. First is the modern rice mill in this device which is fully automated and labour saving one. Second, the working mechanism of 'onion peeler' the skin of the onion is peeled off by the machine. When the onion is placed in the high-speed rotating bin, it rotates around vigorously and finally it gives skin peeled off onion. Next, is the onion curing cum storage machine. Here the onions are cultivated manually and stored at an optimum temperature. This is used to store onion over a period of 9 months with minimum change in colour and weight.

The students visited a pilot plant parboiling unit and learn the mechanisms of pilot plant parboiling unit. In the food processing business incubation centre, they were allowed to view the pre-and post-operative extruder lines with the capacity of 50ml. FPBIC 18 pasta making machine here the making of pasta and chocos were viewed.
