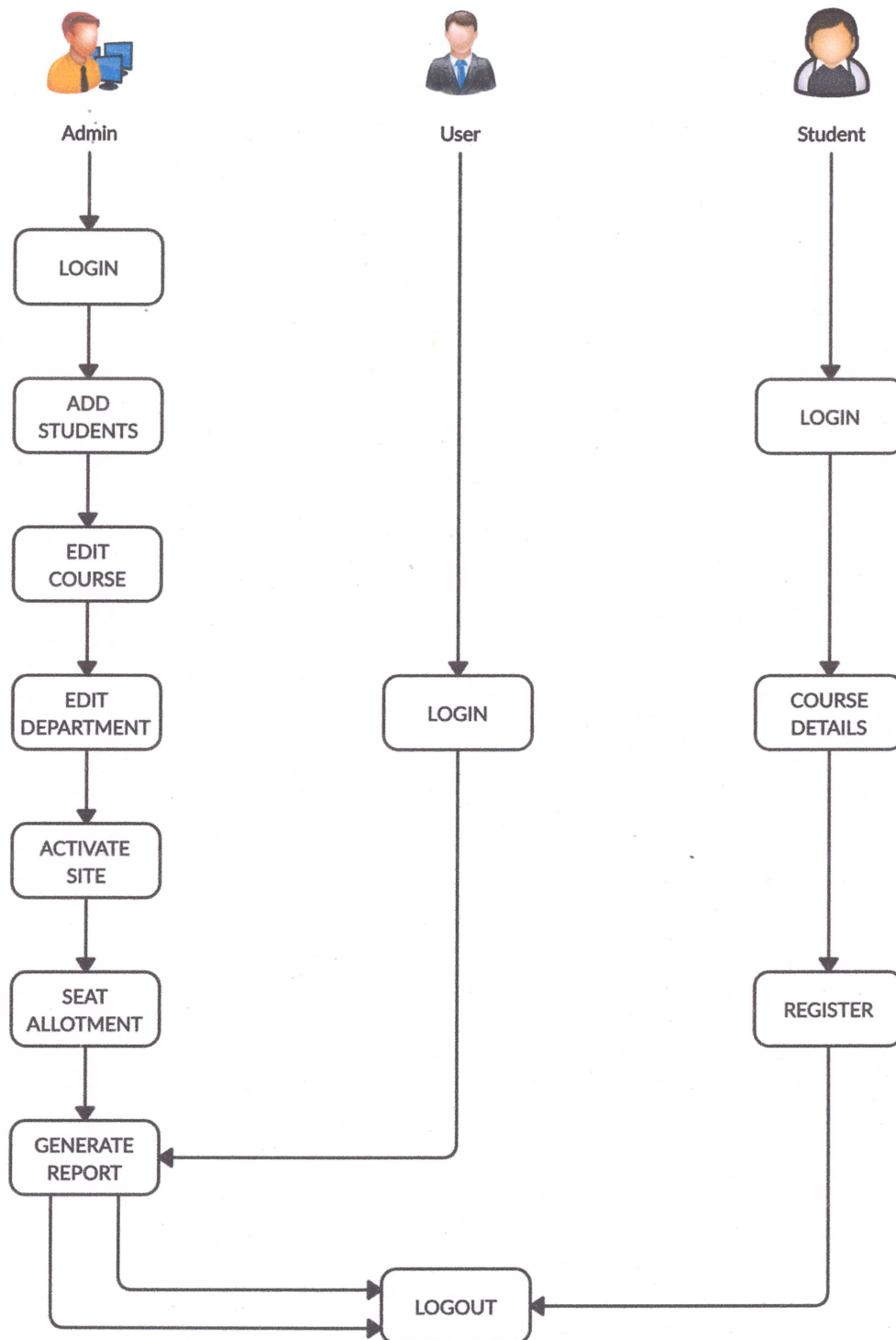

### ➤ Attendance management

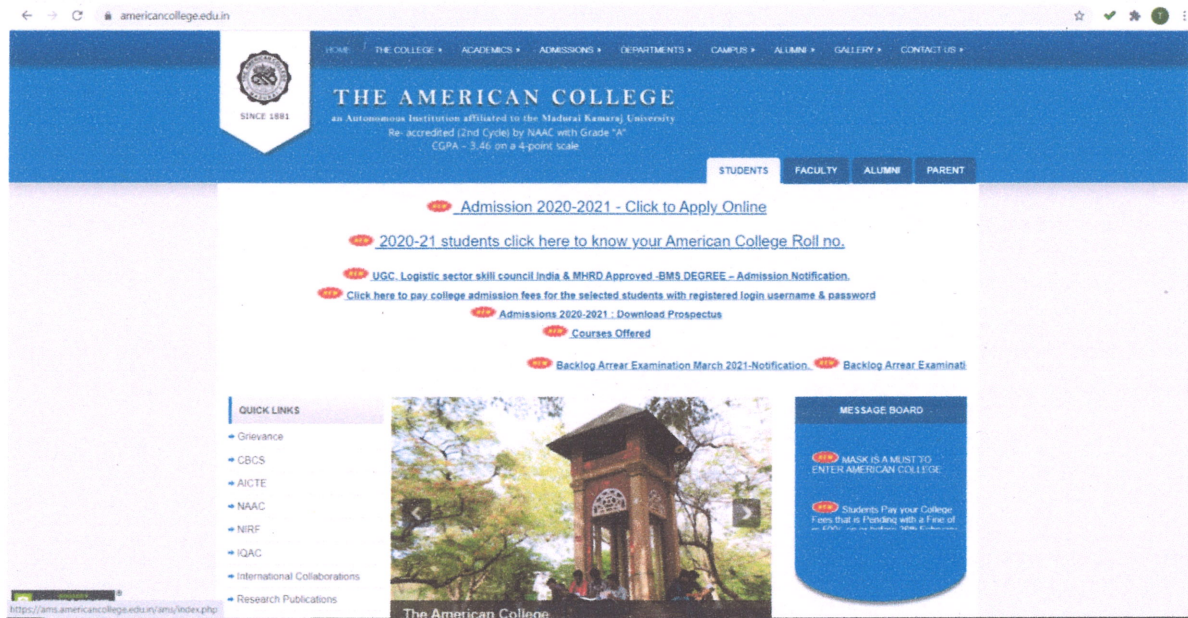

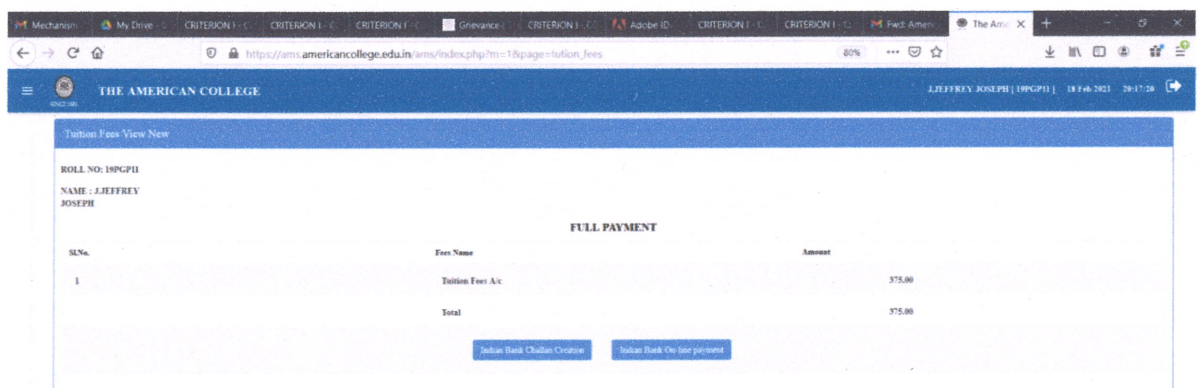
