

# MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

Anugraha Institute of Social Sciences, Nochodaipatty, represented by Rev. Fr. Dr. R. Essac, Principal Hereafter designated as the 'AISS',

The following has been agreed upon:

# **ARTICLE 1: Object of the MoU**

The American College, Madurai is a 138-year-old autonomous institution, reaccredited by NAAC with Grade A & CGPA of 3,46 on a 4 point. Academic autonomy was conferred on it in 1978 and it has been chosen for the UGC supported Community College and B.VocProgramme recently. Its focus is on academic excellence in higher education and social relevance in its delivery. Today, the College has 9000+ students on its roll and it offers 25 UG programmes, 4 B.VocProgrammes, 14 PG programmes, 10 MPhil programmes, and 9 PhD programmes.

Anugraha Institute of Social Sciences is a 10-year-old self-financed institution. It was established and is managed and run by the Congregation of the Capuchins of Tamil Nadu (OFM, CAP). Its mission is to Educate, Develop and Serve the rural and poor youth especially the girls. It offers 10 UG programmes, 7 PG programmes, 2 MPhil programmes and 3 PhD programmes.

# ARTICLE 2: Partnership between AMC and AISS

The American College, Madurai and Anugraha Institute of Social Sciences, Nochodaipattyare willing to participate in the UGC Scheme called "Paramarsh.' It aims at mentoring NAAC Accreditation Aspirant Institutions to promote Quality Assurance in Higher Education.

Under this agreement, The American College is known as "Mentor" Institution and Anugraha Institute of Social Sciences is known as "Mentee" Institution.

# ARTICLE 3: Responsibilities of the Mentor & Mentee Institutions

#### Responsibilities of the Mentor Institution

- Training of faculty and staff of the mentee institution for proper processes, documentation, presentation,
- ii. Guiding the mentee institution for their application procedure at different stages,
- iii. Sharing of knowledge, information and resources with the mentee institution,
- iv. Offering opportunities to the mentee institution for research collaboration and faculty development, and
- v. Guiding and encouraging the mentee institution to adopt best practices.

#### Responsibilities of the Mentee Institution

- i. Nominating one fulltime faculty member as the Coordinator of the project,
- ii. Willing to bring about enhancement in the overall quality of the institution,
- iii. Setting apart the quality time for preparing for NAAC accreditation
- iv. Creating IQAC with committed faculty members, and
- v. Sending the faculty to the mentor institution for seminars, talks, and consultations.

#### **ARTICLE 4: Financial Commitment**

The mentor institution will meet all expenses toward organizing workshops, training, and guest lectures for the mentoring institution from the funds to be sanctioned by the UGC under the scheme. It will not charge the mentee institution.

#### **ARTICLE 5: Cancellation of the MoU**

The mentor and the mentee institutions are firmly and irrevocably committed. However, due to unforeseen circumstances or non-respect of the parties' obligation, this agreement between the mentor and mentee institution can be denounced by the parties with a two months' written notice.

#### **ARTICLE 6: Validity of the Agreement**

The present MoU is valid for one year from the day of the UGC approval. However, it can be extended for one more year with the approval from the UGC.
